- L l :- Lion, Laptop, Ladder, Lock, Lizard, Leaf.
F f :- Fan, Frog, Fish, Fire, Friends, Fingers.
E e :- Egg, Elephant, Engine, Elbow, Eyes, Ears.
T t :- Tomato, Tiger, Train, Tortoise, Track, Teacher.

Rhymes :- All common rhymes of English & Hindi –
Johny – Johny, Twinkle – Twinkle, one two – Buckle my shoe, Baa – Baa Black Sheep,

NUMBERS :-

Pre- number concepts:- Big and Small, Tall and Short

General Awareness :- Few things are being told everyday in class

H h :- Horse, Hammer, House, Hills, Handkerchief, Hat

A a :- Ambulance, Aeroplane, Aquarium, Animal, Apple

N n :- Nose, Nest, New, Neck, Necklace, Net, Nurse.

4) Throw waste in the bins.

Alphabet song with phonetic sounds.

Alphabet Recognition :- V, M, X, Z, Y, W & K with their pictures, sounds & words for vocabulary enhancement like

V v	:-	Van, Vase, Vegetables, Volcano, Vest
M m	:-	Moon, Mushroom, Mop, Mummy, Madam, Music
X x	:-	X-mas tree, X-Ray, Xylophone
Z z	:-	Zoo, Zig-Zag, Zero, Zebra, Zoom
Y y	:-	Yak, Yo-Yo, Yogurt, Yawn, Yummy
W w	:-	Window, Wool, Watermelon, Watch, Welcome
K k	:-	Kite, King, Keys, Kettle, Kangaroo

Recognition of numbers (1 to 10) with different exercises on black-board & tracing of the same in worksheet booklet)

General Knowledge :- - My School (colour of the building, places like Canteen, Library, Activity Room, Theatre, Computer Room, Statue of Lord Ganesha & Mother Mary, Swings, Mango Trees etc.)
- Vegetables (Names & Colours of different vegetables; Brinjal is the king of vegetables, etc.)

General Awareness :- Few things are being told everyday in class

2) Throw waste in the bins.

4) Develop a habit of saying prayers.

Alphabet Recognition :- A to Z with their pictures, sounds & words (atleast 3 words from each) for vocabulary enhancement. Take help from WORD BANK in rhyme book.
